^a *non-performance, as decided by the Employer, shall include all contracts where (a) non-performance was not challenged by the contractor, including through referral to the dispute resolution mechanism under the respective contract, and (b) contracts that were so challenged but fully settled against the contractor. Non-performance shall not include contracts where Employers decision was overruled by the dispute resolution mechanism. Non-performance must be based on all information on fully settled disputes or litigation, i.e. dispute or litigation that has been resolved in accordance with the dispute resolution mechanism under the respective contract and where all appeal instances available to the Tenderer have been exhausted.*

^b *This requirement also applies to contracts executed by the Tenderer as Joint Venture member.*

4.1.5.2 Pending Litigation and Arbitration

Pending litigation and arbitration criterion shall not normally apply. However, AEGCL shall have the discretion to take due cognizance of the matter under litigation/arbitration if the matter appears to be of serious nature in the opinion of AEGCL. Under such circumstances necessary clarification may be sought by AEGCL to proceed ahead with the evaluation.

- 2) All rates are to be quoted in INR only.
- 3) ITB 2.20.1 Bid Security: The Bid Security will be 35 Crore instead of 24 Crore.
- 4) The First Appellate for this tender is Secretary, Power Department and Second Appellate is Commissioner and Secretary, Finance Department, Govt. of Assam
- 5) SCC 8.2: "The Time for Completion of the whole of the Facilities shall be 36 (Thirty-Six) months from the Effective Date as described in the Contract Agreement. Contractor shall have to complete the part of the facilities within the Work schedule finalized as per the Appendix-4, Section-9 (Contract Form). The employer has the right to award the uncompleted part of the facilities which by the contractor at the scheduled timeline to next lowest quoted tenderer by pre-closing of the contract "may be read as **"The Time for Completion of the whole of the Facilities shall be 36 (Thirty-Six) months from the Effective Date as described in the Contract Agreement. Contractor shall have to complete the part of the facilities within the Work schedule finalized as per the Appendix-4, Section-9 (Contract Form). The Uncompleted work will be executed as per the guidelines of Assam State Procurement Act 2017 and Assam State Procurement Rules 2020 and notifications issued time to time by Govt. of Assam.**
- 6) ITB 4.2.2(b) The Minimum Average Annual Turnover should be taken as Rs. 1600 Crore (Rupees Sixteen Hundred Crore) certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed, within the last three (3) years.

All other terms and conditions of the bid document shall remain same.
